Twin Valley Middle School Session Three (2009-2010) (January 11 - February 18)

Thanks to Chef Lonny, we will be running Iron Chef again this session. Sixty five middle school students have shown an interest in participating. The final competition will be held in our gym in March.

PLEASE NOTE: You must fill out the Wings registration form to participate in the Iron Chef or any other program offered by Wings.

Wings' fee structure is intended to encourage families to contribute what they can afford. Rather than a clear fee for each program, Wings *suggests* a contribution of \$20 per program (a little more than \$3 per day). MONDAYS

(Jan. 11, 25, Feb. 1 & 8)

1. **Webpage/Podcasts** w/Mr. Daniels. Students will help maintain teacher web pages and update them with pertinent information. Additionally, students will create a weekly podcast that **WILL** be published to iTunes.

TUESDAYS

(Jan. 12, 26, Feb. 2, 9, 16)

2. **Basic Clothes Construction (part I)** w/Ms. Maddern. Using applied mathematics, students will learn to see “inside out”, use accurate measurement and skills necessary for construction of basic clothing. In this program, you will (1) make a body form unique to you for measurement and fitting purposes and to help with your own alterations of patterns, (2) explore patterns, drape and fit of cloth, sewing skills, and (3) sew a final project.
3. **Chess Club** w/Mr. Marsh. Have you ever wanted to learn Chess, or better your skills in playing Chess? Here is your chance! Students will use Chessmaster 10th edition (a computerized program), chess boards and the internet to learn strategies and learn about the history of the game. A tournament against another team will take place before the end of the program.

WEDNESDAYS

(Jan 13, 20, 27, Feb. 3, 10 & 17)

4. **Animation Shop** w/Mr. Daniels. Students will use Jase Paint Shop Pro and Animation Shop to create real, working animations. Different methods and types of animations will also be discussed and explored. Students will build on comic strip/storytelling skills from art and English classes.

Iron Chef w/Chef Lonny and his assistant program leaders. One of our most popular programs, Iron Chef will run different teams on **Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday**. This program will teach students how to cook using fresh local produce in a competitive environment. Three to five students along with one leader will make up each team that will strive to be the best “**Iron Chef Team**” in the competition that takes place in March.

Homework Club will be offered on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

PLEASE NOTE: This is not a “hang out” place to wait for practices or games to begin. Please bring homework and a reading book with you. A minimum of ½ hour of reading or homework will be mandatory.

We have purchased several board games to play when homework is completed. Computer use will be limited to school work only.
